Interdisciplinary Workshop on Sovereignty and European Integration

“Sovereignty and European Integration in the ‘Post-Constitutional’ Era”

The aftermath of the attempts at constitutional reform in the EU as well as the uncertainties resulting from global financial turmoil constitute perhaps the most prolonged period of crisis in the EU's history. In this workshop, these and other key questions will be addressed through the register of sovereignty; both as a potential cause of crisis (e.g. the resurgence of Member State sovereignty through referendum results), but also as a potential solution to crisis (e.g. through the coordination of measures at the European level to face global instability). Adopting approaches to sovereignty from law and political science, the workshop will examine sovereignty-related aspects of European integration to provide context to the current issues facing the integration process.
