CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Applications are invited of abstracts of papers to be presented at the UK IVR Conference, to be held on Friday 30 May - Saturday 31 May 2008, at the School of Law, University of Edinburgh.

The theme for the Conference is **New Directions in Legal and Social Theory**.

The deadline for abstracts is **Monday 28 January 2008**. Abstracts are to be 500-800 words in length. Abstracts are to be sent to Burkhard Schafer: B.Schafer@ed.ac.uk.

An International Selection Panel of prominent legal theorists will decide the successful presenters by Monday 11 February 2008.

The Conference will have two keynote speakers: **Professor Cecile Fabre** (Edinburgh) and **Professor Les Green** (Oxford).

The Entry Fees for the Conference are as follows:
